All financial obligations must be fulfilled before surgery.
Make sure your blood work is done and the Institute has a copy of the test results.
Please check that you have received a copy of your prescriptions.
Do not take aspirin or aspirin containing products (see separate sheet for what to avoid) for two weeks prior to surgery.
Do not drink any alcohol 48 hours before surgery and then wait post-operatively until antibiotics are finished.
If you smoke, <u>please</u> try to cut down or stop at least two week before surgery. This will help your body to heal better
If you take any medications on a routine basis, please continue to do so, but advise the doctor and his nurse so they can tell you what to take the day of surgery.
You cannot drive yourself home. Please have a responsible adult pick you up and stay with you for the first 24 hours. You will need to leave the name and telephone number of the person picking you up at the front desk.
Do not take pain medication until after surgery.

EYELID SURGERY POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. After surgery, you will have a slight haze over your eyes. This is from ointment we have applied. It will melt by the next day. We will let you know about the use of eye drops
- 2. Apply cold packs to eyes for 10-15 minutes every hour while awake. Gel packs are most convenient. Ice -packs or frozen peas may be use.
- 3. We strongly recommend that you keep your head elevated using 2 or 3 pillows in bed: or, sleep in a recliner chair. Keeping your head elevated and ice packs on your eyes are the most important post-operative instruction.
- 4. If you must go out in the sunshine, wear dark glasses to protect your eyes. You may be photosensitive for a few weeks.
- 5. Cleanse sutures line twice daily with Q-tips and peroxide.
- 6. Do not self-medicate with your own painkillers, sleeping pills, muscle relaxants or narcotics. Only take those medications prescribed by your treating physician after surgery. Self-medicating could lead to drug toxicity or death. Take your prescription pain reliever as directed. You may substitute, or alternate, plain or extra-strength Tylenol as needed.
- 7. Do not lift, push, or pull anything weighing more than 10 pounds for 2 weeks.
- 8. Please make sure to keep your post-operative appointment with the doctor.
